



Our Topic this half term is:

Nursery Rhymes, Traditional Stories and Autumn Festivals

We will be:

- Learning new Nursery Rhymes.
- Reading and retelling 'The Three Little Pigs', 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' and 'Three Billy Goats Gruff'.
- Going on a Bear Hunt.
- Finding out what changes take place in Autumn.
- Learning how people celebrate Diwali.
- Our focus this half term will be settling children into school and establishing relationships and routines.

How can you help your child at home?

- Reading a variety of traditional stories.
- Singing Nursery Rhymes together.
- Helping your child to retell key phrases from stories e.g. 'He huffed and he puffed and he blew the house down!'
- Talk to your child about the changes that take place during autumn.
- Identifying numbers in the environment.
- Counting up to 5 objects.
- Saying number names in order.

In Literacy we will be ...

- Recognising and writing our name every day.
- Making marks and talking about them.
- Sharing books together.
- Retelling stories using small world resources.
- Writing what happens during autumn time.



In Creative and the World activities we will be

- Making prints of pigs using different shapes.
- Having a 'The Three Bears Cottage'.
- Making Divas.
- Going on a Bear Hunt!
