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Dear Parents,

Our theme for this week has been, 'Sun Safety'. In assembly on Monday we discussed the 3 main ways to keep safe in the sun and the children learnt 3 words as a useful prompt to help them to do this: 'Wrap', 'Splat' and 'Hat'.

1. 'Wrap' refers to ensuring that skin is covered to protect the skin from the dangerous UV rays.
2. 'Splat' reminds the children to use a sun protection cream with a minimum SPF of 30
3. 'Hat' is a prompt to ensure that children remember to wear sun hats, that preferably cover the back of their neck as additional protection.



On days when we are expecting high levels of sunshine please ensure that children come to school in a sun hat and have preferably applied a high sun factor protection cream before coming to school. We really want to help prevent the ultraviolet rays damaging skin prematurely and leaving children with an increased risk of skin cancer later in their lives.

From September, all children from Year 3 onwards will have a weekly French lesson and this has been the perfect way to launch our new learning with all of the children.
