

Dear Parents,

Transition has got off to a great start with children from Year 1 to Year 6 moving to their new class teachers. Reception children have spent the week in the Reception class with Miss Preston and their new teacher, Miss Jackaman. Next week, they will be moving into their new Y1 class with Miss Jackaman, Mrs Walker and Miss Witczak and starting their new routines.

I am delighted to announce that throughout the year, we have had a total of 145 children who have been an 'Always Bee.' To reward the 'Always Bees,' a trip to the cinema to watch 'Rio 2' is planned for next Friday. The consultation period is from July 1<sup>st</sup> to July 28<sup>th</sup> 2014 and there is a form attached if you have any comments to make. You all received a letter yesterday, regarding the **school closure** which is planned for **Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> July**, due to industrial action from NUT, UNISON and GMB. School will open as normal on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> July. Thank you.
